Architects from around the world are invited to submit their ideas on the main theme or one of the following subthemes:

RESILIENCE: the alleviation of poverty, spatial economies, and emergence

ECOLOGY: as related to notions of time, evolution, systems, processes, and long-term decision making

VALUES: new approaches to professional practice, teaching and raising awareness about architecture
